Eco schools:

Four GF holders: Buglawton Primary, Saint Mary's Catholic Primary, Marfields Academy & Smallwood. All other schools defaulted to silver.

Three schools are Young Tree Champion Clubs/schools (Marfields, Saint Mary's & Smallwood primaries), they are developing their tree trail projects now. Saint Mary's has started to run weekly Forest Schools sessions. RSPB birdwatch at Saint Mary's.
